

Skykomish Success Story

The small District of Skykomish has been making great strides in their science safety and hazardous chemical management. A team of three employees have used all the possible resources to keep students and employees safe and follow legal requirements. Our PSWCT Industrial Hygiene Consultant, Elizabeth Jakab teamed up with Sue Hamilton from the field team at King Count's Hazardous Waste Management Program to combine on-site consultation with financial support. During the last calendar year, the district purchased a new safety shower for the science lab with \$600 in support from a King County voucher. This fall they received another two vouchers (value of \$1200) to purchase and install safety equipment and personal protective equipment for Maintenance & Operations Department and the Transportation shop. The Hazardous Waste Program also donated a brand new, complete universal spill kit to the District.
